METRIC TIME!

Metric vs. normal	Metric	normal
Seconds per minute	100	60
Minutes per hour	100	60
Hours a day	10	24
Days per month	10	Varies
# of months	10	12
Days per year	100	Varies

So, there would be 10,000,000 seconds in a Metric year as opposed to 31,536,000 seconds in a normal year. So it would take about 3.15 Metric years to equal a normal year. The fractions of a second would be kept the same (i.e. tenths of a second, milliseconds.) But why make a Metric time?
