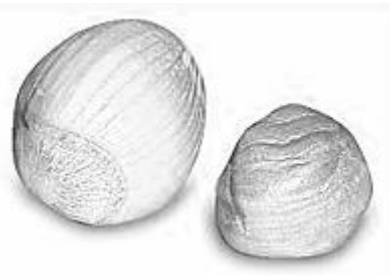




If Tuesday Weld married Jack Ruby, she'd be Tuesday Ruby.
