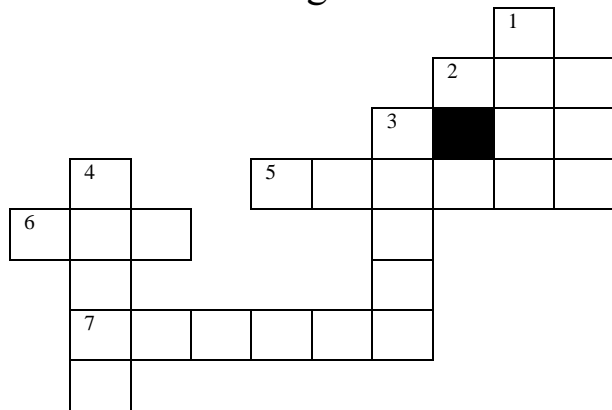


Hi. Welcome to another one. Big Belch News that is. Let's start with a puzzle.

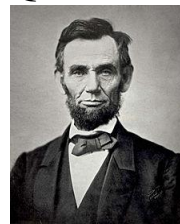
