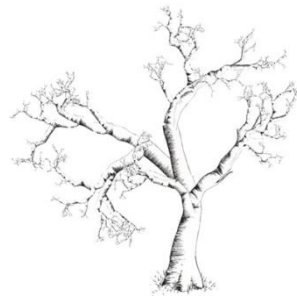
Dentist.
