

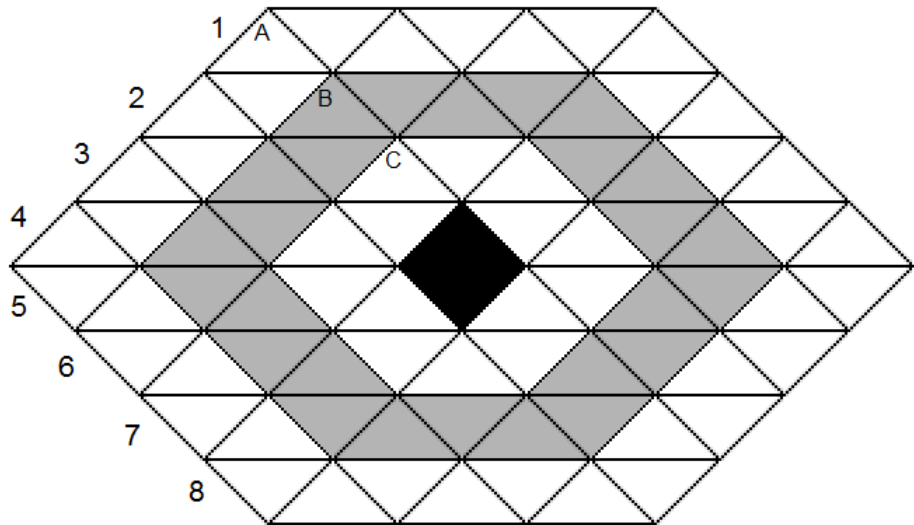
The Hexagon #1
